
## *Just Ask:*

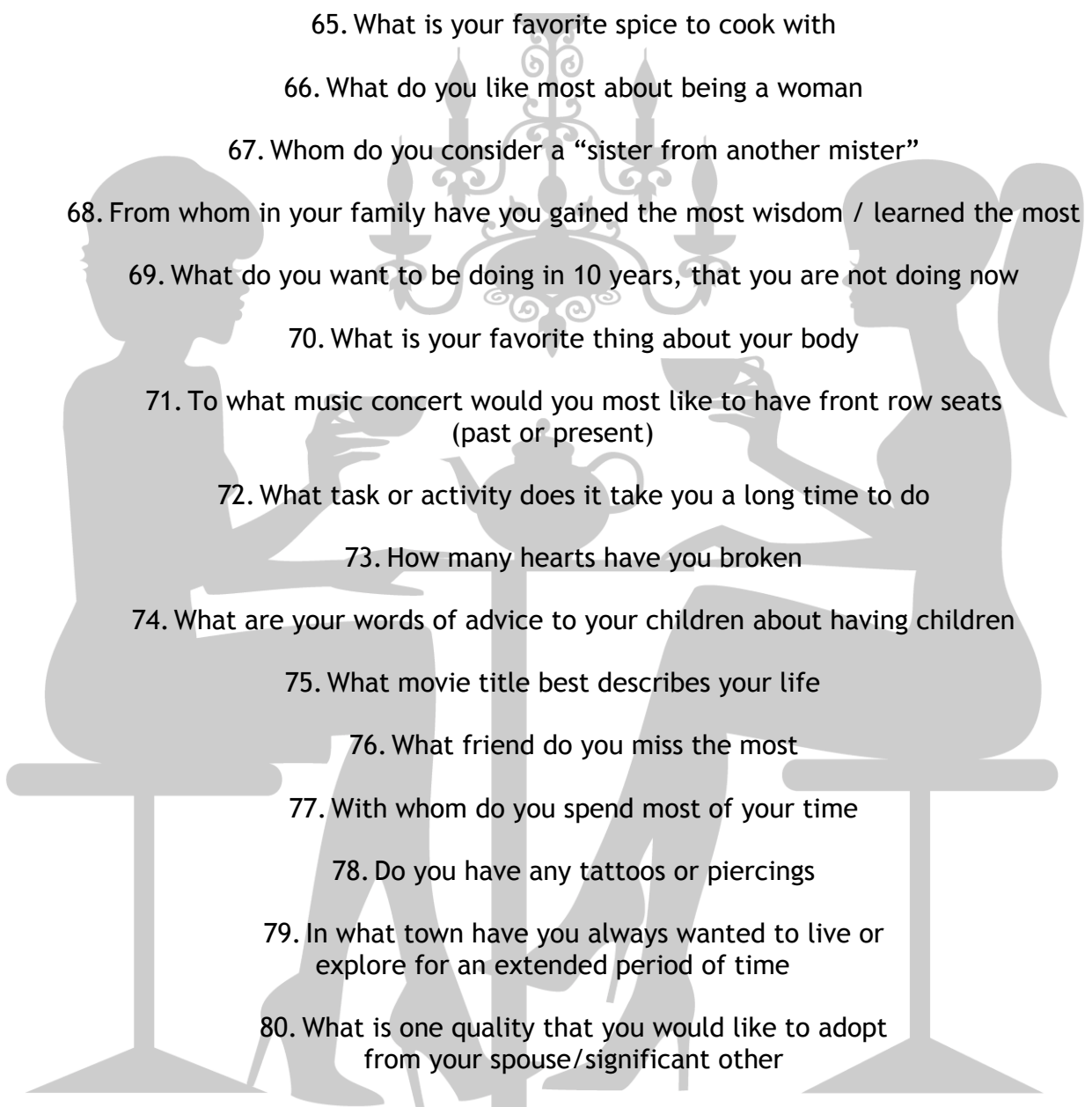
